## ASYLUM TRENDS IN INDUSTRIALIZED COUNTRIES - JANUARY 2003

1. In 26 industrialized countries for which data were available, 33,820 asylum applications were submitted in January 2003, 6 per cent more than in December 2002, when 31,770 applications were lodged. In the 21 European asylum countries with available data, monthly applications rose with 4 per cent, in North America an increase of 12 per cent was recorded, whereas Australia and New Zealand experienced an 8 per cent rise (*Table 1*).
2. Of the 26 countries reporting data for December 2002 and January 2003, 16 experienced an increase in monthly asylum applications, whereas 10 countries reported a decrease. A relatively significant **increase** in monthly applications was reported by Bulgaria (169%), Finland (46%), Germany (30%), Greece (31%), Netherlands (34%), Spain (99%), Switzerland (28%), Canada (25%) and New Zealand (100%). Conversely, an important **decrease** in applications was reported by Hungary (-29%) and Slovakia (-60%) (*Table 1*).
3. In the 26 industrialized countries with available data, monthly asylum claims lodged by Iraqi nationals, the main asylum-seeker nationality, rose with 37 per cent. Another important monthly increase (113%) was recorded by Pakistani asylum-seekers, mostly due to a steep rise in applications in Canada (from 370 to 1000).
4. Detailed trends by country of asylum and origin are provided in Table 3 (December 2002) and 4 (January 2003).
